## The Customs and Excise Act (Laws, Volume 18, Cap. 322)

## The Customs and Excise (Excise Duty) (Cut rag) (Suspension) Regulations, 2018

In exercise of the powers contained in section 89 of the Customs and Excise Act, the following Regulations are made:

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Excise Duty) (Cut rag) (Suspension) Regulations, 2018.

Title and commencement

- (2) These regulations are deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 2018.
- 2. (1) The excise duty on the goods listed in the Schedule is suspended to the extent shown in the Schedule.

Suspension of excise duty

- (2) A suspension under subregulation (1) shall be granted to a licensed manufacturer of tobacco products where the goods are—
  - (a) imported directly by the licensed manufacturer in accordance with the provisions of the Act; and
  - (b) taken out of a bonded warehouse in accordance with Regulation 56 of the Customs and Excise (General) Regulations, 2000.

(3) A licensed manufacturer shall not use or dispose of the goods imported or taken out of bond pursuant to these Regulations without the consent of the Commissioner-General.
