## The National Forest No. F45: Kipushi (Alteration of Boundaries) Order, 2018

In exercise f the powers contained in section 10 of the Forests Act, the following Order is made:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the National Forest No. F45: Title Kipushi (Alteration of Boundaries) Order, 2018.
- 2. The boundaries of the National Forest No. F45: Kipushi are altered by the deletion of the existing boundary description and the substitution therefor of the boundary description specified in the Schedule.

Alteration of boundaries

3. Statutory Instrument No. 158 of 1975 is amended accordingly.

Amendment of SI No. 158 of 1975

## SCHEDULE (Paragraph 2)

National Forest No. F45: Kipushi

Starting at Beacon FB1 the boundary runs eastwards direction for a distance of approximately 5,250 meters to Beacon FB2 on the Zambia-Congo D.R International Boundary; thence along this international boundary in a southeasterly direction through intermediate Beacon B.P. 27/IV/F to intermediate Beacon B.P. 27/IV/C; thence in a northerly direction through Beacons B.P. 27/IV/B to Beacon B.P. 27/IV/A, through Beacons B.P.27/IV, BP27/III and BP27/II to Beacon B.P. 27/I/G; thence on a bearing of approximately 245 degrees for a distance of approximately 2,900 metres to Beacon BM1; thence on a bearing of approximately 304 degrees for a distance of approximately 4,183 metres to Beacon BM2; thence on a bearing of approximately 1,931 metres to Beacon BM3; thence on a bearing of approximately 1,931 metres to Beacon BM3; thence on a bearing of approximately 2,576 metres to Beacon BM4; thence on a bearing of approximately 2,90 degrees for a distance of approximately 4,667 metres to Beacon BM5; thence in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 100 metres to Beacon FB1, the point of starting.

The above described area, in extent 2,884 hectares approximately, is shown bordered green on Plan No. F.R/15/3 deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General, signed and dated  $22^{\rm nd}$  March, 2018.
