The Forests Act, 2015 (Act No. 4 of 2015)

The Local Forest No F27: Lusaka East (Alteration of Boundaries) Order, 2018

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 17 of the Forests Act, 2015, the following Order is made:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Local Forest No. F27: Title Lusaka East (Alteration of Boundaries) Order, 2018.
- 2. The boundaries of the Local Forest No. F27: Lusaka East, are altered by the deletion of existing boundary description and the substitution therefor of the boundary description specified in the Schedule.

Alteration of boundaries

3. Statutory Instrument No. 161 of 1996, is amended accordingly.

Amendment of SI No. 161 of 1996

SCHEDULE (Paragraph 2)

Stating at beacon B79, the boundary runs in a northeasterly direction for a distance of approximately 5,124 metres passing through beacon B82 to beacon B72 on the western boundary of Farm No. 382a; thence in a southeasterly direction to beacon B91 crossing the Chalimbana River to beacon GAU for a distance of approximately 2,510 metres; thence along the western side of Farm 28a through beacon MA221 to beacon F3 for a distance of approximately 1,912 metres; thence along the western boundary of Farm No. 298a for a distance of approximately 2,193 metres to beacon BM1; thence in a westerly direction following the powerline for a distance of approximately 1,270 metres to beacon BM2 on the eastern boundary of Farm No. 487a; thence in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 1,411 metres on the right bank of Chalimbana River, thence down the Chalimbana River to its confluence with unnamed stream forming the northern boundary of Farm 2242; thence up this stream to the western corner of Farm No. 2241; thence along the eastern boundary of Farm No. 487a in a northwesterly direction for a distance of approximately 911 metres to beacon B83; thence in a northwesterly direction through beacon BM3 for a distance of approximately 2,525 metres to beacon B79, the point of starting.

Included in the above described area but excluded from the local forest are the following areas:

- (a) Area 1 (200.8 Hectares);
- (b) Area 2 (174.6 Hectares); and
- (c) Area 3 (129.0 Hectares) for Zambia Air Force (ZAF) Twin Palm Base mixed use infrastructure development.

The above described area, in extent 1,193 hectares approximately, is shown bordered green on Plan No. FR 10/4 deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General, signed by the Surveyor General and dated 1st March, 2018.
